Obetz Athletics' Coaches Code of Conduct

As a coach or assistant coach for Obetz Athletics, I agree to set a good example for players, team coaches, and supporters. I will do my best to teach fundamental techniques and skills while also exhibiting good sportsmanship. I will encourage my players, other coaches, and team supporters to extend a hand of friendship to all opponents and their supporters. I will not perform or tolerate unsportsmanlike behavior from other coaches, players, or spectators. These actions include, but are not limited to:

- Abusing, either verbally or physically, an umpire, any player, any coach, parents/guardians, spectators, or league officials;
- Consuming of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances while in the complex or at practice;
- Being under the influence of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances during the game or at practice;
- Being in possession of a firearm or weapon, except for law enforcement personnel;
- Expressing obscenities, racial slurs, or gestures that are inappropriate or demeaning;
- Inciting or encouraging abusive and dangerous actions from players or spectators;
- Baiting, ridiculing and/or threatening an umpire, any player, any manager/coach, parents/guardians, spectators, or league officials;
- Using profanity and/or derogatory language; any body language deemed inappropriate.

I further understand that when an incident occurs, the game will be stopped and offending persons will be asked to leave the property. The game will not continue until the persons comply with this request. If the persons refuse to leave, the umpire will immediately suspend the game and notify a league official. Offending persons will be dealt with by proper authorities. All incidents will be reported to the Village of Obetz, who will investigate all actions reported, and follow up with all parties.

I agree to cooperate fully with the Village of Obetz in correcting any problems or disagreements that may arise; and acknowledge that any coach, parent, or adult spectator who is ejected from a game for any reason will be permanently banned from participating in or attending any Obetz Athletics program or event.

I also understand that all parents of children participating in the 2012 Football and Cheerleading Obetz Athletics season have agreed to follow these following rules:

1. Display sportsmanlike conduct. Do not criticize officials, players, coaches or fans.
2. Encourage children and keep comments positive.
3. Wear proper apparel at all practices and games.
4. Address officials and coaches by appropriate titles.
5. Notify the coach of any absence.
6. Do not use foul language or obscene gestures.
7. Do not smoke on or near the playing fields.
8. Clean up their trash after each practice and game.
