**PASSED: February 10, 2014**

**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION THE FINAL AUTHORITY TO UNDERTAKE THE INTERSTATE 270 PROJECT PID NUMBER 83988 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Obetz is the Local Public Agency (LPA); and,

**WHEREAS**, on September 9, 2013 Obetz Village Council adopted Ordinance 48-13, proposing cooperation with the Director of Transportation for the project consisting of the rehabilitation of the Alum Creek Drive structure over IR 270, lying within the Village of Obetz; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) has estimated that Obetz' share in the cost of the project is estimated in the amount of One Hundred Twenty Six Thousand Fifty Four and 68/100 Dollars, (\$126,054.68), but said estimated amount is to be adjusted in order that Obetz' ultimate share of said improvement shall correspond with said percentages of actual costs when said actual costs are determined; and,

**WHEREAS**, Obetz desires aesthetic rail treatments and agrees to assume and bear 100 percent of the entire cost of the improvement of the aesthetic rail treatment and associated costs; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Transportation has approved said legislation proposing cooperation and has caused to be made plans and specifications and an estimate of cost and expense for improving the above described highway and has transmitted copies of the same to this legislative authority; and,

**WHEREAS**, Obetz desires the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ THAT;**

Section 1. The estimated sum of One Hundred Twenty Six Thousand Fifty Four and 68/100 Dollars, (\$126,054.68), is hereby appropriated for the improvement described above and the Mayor and/or Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to issue an order to the Finance Director for said sum upon the requisition of the Director of Transportation to pay the cost and expense of said improvement. Further, Obetz agrees to assume in the first instance, the share of the cost and expense over and above the amount to be paid from Federal funds.

Section 2. Obetz hereby requests the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

Section 3. Obetz shall enter into a contract with the State, and the Village Administrator and/or Mayor be, and is hereby authorized to execute said contract, providing for the payment of the LPA the sum of money set forth herein above for improving the described project.

Section 4. Obetz shall transmit a fully executed copy of this Ordinance to the Director of Transportation.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be declared an emergency necessary for the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Obetz, such emergency arising from the need to expedite the transportation project and to promote transportation safety; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
