ORDINANCE: 19-14

PASSED: April 14, 2014

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR A CONTRACTING PROCEDURE FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE TOY ROAD (SK FOODS) CURB CUT, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Obetz ("Village") desires to waive competitive bidding and establish a specific contracting procedure for purposes of negotiating a proposal and entering into a contract for construction of a new curb cut and turn lane ("Curb Cut Project") to serve the building located at 3301 Toy Road in the City of Groveport, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Council is empowered to enact ordinances for the waiver of competitive bidding in the awarding of contracts by Section 8.02(C) of the Village Charter; and,

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Village of Obetz and its citizens that The OPUS Group be chosen as the contractor for the construction of the Curb Cut Project, and that the Village Administrator further be empowered to negotiate with The OPUS Group to ensure that the construction contract provide for the most efficient, cost-effective and beneficial construction process for the Village of Obetz.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, no less than five members of Council concurring:

Section 1. That Council hereby finds and declares that, as a "home rule" charter village, Obetz shall not be obligated to follow statutory procedures regarding contracting, including but not limited to Ohio Revised Code Sections 721.01-721.03, 9.312, 9.313, 9.32, 9.33-9.332, 153.12-153.14, 153.50-153.52, 153.34, 153.56-153.571, 153.67-153.71, 735.05-735.09, and other applicable sections within O.R.C. Chapter 153.

Section 2. That, pursuant to Section 8.02(C) of the Village Charter, Village Council hereby waives competitive bidding with regard to the contract for construction of the Curb Cut Project, and hereby determines that such contract shall be awarded to The OPUS Group. Council hereby empowers the Village Administrator to negotiate with The OPUS Group to ensure that the construction contract provides for the most efficient, cost-effective, and beneficial construction process for the Village of Obetz pursuant to a project delivery method selected by the Mayor pursuant to Section 8.02(D) of the Village Charter.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety and for the

further reason that there exists the immediate necessity to provide for the most efficient and beneficial construction process of the Curb Cut Project, to attract hundreds of new jobs to the Obetz region; WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
