ORDINANCE: 31-14

PASSED: June 9, 2014

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO AWARD THE CONTRACT FOR THE ALUM CREEK/MAUREEN TRAFFIC SIGNAL TO U.S. UTILITY CONTRACTOR AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has requested and received informal bids for the erection of a traffic signal at the intersection of Alum Creek Drive and Maureen Boulevard (the "Project"); and,

WHEREAS, U.S. Utility Contractor was the lowest and best bidder for said project; and,

WHEREAS, Council desires to award the bid for the Project to U.S. Utility Contractor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Village Council awards the bid for the Project to U.S. Utility Contractor as the lowest and best bidder for the project.

Section 2. The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into a contract with U.S. Utility Contractor in the approximate amount of \$175,000.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be declared an emergency and shall take effect from and after its passage. The reason for the emergency is to provide for the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Obetz, specifically, the Village needs to establish signalization at the intersection before the opening of the Vance Outdoors store and the increased traffic anticipated therewith.
