

VILLAGE OF OBETZ RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

REGULAR MEETING OF MARCH 10, 2014

The Obetz Village Council met in regular session on March 10, 2014 at 6:00 PM at the Obetz Government Center located at 4175 Alum Creek Drive with Mayor D. Greg Scott presiding.

ROLL CALL

Mayor Scott called the roll with five members of Council present: Mrs. Bonnie Wiley, Mr. James Wiley, Mr. Michael Flaherty, Mr. Guiles Richardson, and Mrs. Angie Kirk. Also present were Michael Confer, Chief of Police; Eve Ellinger, Law Director, and, Stacey Boumis, Community Services Director/Council Clerk.

Emergencies

Ms. Boumis read Ordinance 12-14 An Ordinance Modifying Obetz Code Sections 149.05 And 149.10 Regarding Holidays And Overtime And Declaring An Emergency. Ms. Ellinger discussed the Ordinance. Mayor Scott, Council, Ms. Ellinger, and Chief Confer discussed the Ordinance. Ms. Ellinger stated that the Ordinance recognizes all Federal holidays. It gives full time employees more time to use their birthday holiday. It also brings Obetz into compliance with the Fair Labor Standards Act in order to avoid paying unnecessary overtime.
