A ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2014, AN ORDINANCE TO ENACT AN INCREASE IN THE VILLAGE INCOME TAX RATE FROM THE CURRENT RATE OF TWO PERCENT (2.0%) TO A RATE OF TWO AND ONE-HALF PERCENT (2.5%) TO BECOME EFFECTIVE ON JANUARY 1, 2015, FOR THE PURPOSES OF POLICE SERVICES AND OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, Section 718.01 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that no municipal corporation shall levy a tax on income at a rate in excess of one percent (1.0%) without having obtained the approval of excess by the majority of the electors of the municipality voting on the question at a general, primary, or special election; and

WHEREAS, a general election is to be held on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, and Council desires to place on the ballot a proposed increase of the Village of Obetz income tax from 2.0% to 2.5% for the consideration of the electors of the Village of Obetz;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:

- Section 1. Council for the Village of Obetz hereby authorizes and directs the submission to the electors of the Village of Obetz, Ohio, at the General Election to be held Tuesday, November 4, 2014, the question of approving the passage of Ordinance No. 25-2014, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, to enact an ordinance to provide for an additional one-half percent (0.5%) per annum income tax levy in excess of the current two percent (2.0%) levy on income commencing January 1, 2015, for the purposes of police services and operations.
- Section 2. The proposed ordinance to be submitted to the electors of the Village for their approval shall be set for in Ordinance No. 252014, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.
- Section 3. The form of the ballot to be used at such election on the question shall be as follows:

Shall Ordinance No. 25-2014 providing for an additional one-half percent (0.5%) levy on earnings and income subject to the municipal tax, to be effective January 1, 2015, for the purposes of police services and operations?

Section 4.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

Section 5.

All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

Section 6.

This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period provided by law.

Section 7.

The Clerk of Council shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Franklin County Board of Elections at least ninety (90) days prior to the date of the election set forth in Section 1 hereof.
