ORDINANCE: 46-14	PASSED: September 8, 2014

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) TOY ROAD CURB CUT 629 GRANT FUND, APPROPRIATING FUNDS, AUTHORIZING AN ADVANCE FROM THE GENERAL FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Obetz received approval of two grants — a grant from the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) in the amount of \$60,000 and a grant from the Ohio Development Services Agency (DSA 629) in the amount of \$60,000 — for the construction of a curb cut on Toy Road; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio requires the establishment of a new fund in order to account for the grant whose use is restricted to a particular purpose; and,

WHEREAS, Council needs to appropriate the funds for the project; and,

WHEREAS, an advance from the General Fund is needed to pay obligations of the project until the grant proceeds are received;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>: There is hereby established the ODOT Toy Road Curb Cut 629 Grant Fund, as a capital projects fund of the Village, to account for grants from the ODOT and DSA grants, the proceeds from which are to be used for the construction of the Toy Road curb cut.

<u>Section 2</u>: The following funds are hereby appropriated in the ODOT Toy Road Curb Cut 629 Grant Fund:

Capital Outlay

\$120,000

<u>Section 3.</u> For the purpose of providing funds for the ODOT Toy Road Curb Cut 629 Grant Fund, the amount of \$120,000 is hereby advanced from the General Fund. The amount is solely an advance, and is not as a transfer. The advance shall be repaid as the grant proceeds become available and after the obligation of the project are met.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the immediate passage of which is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Obetz, such emergency arising from the immediate need to begin construction of the curb cut during warm weather months and complete the project in a timely

manner in order to attract a new business to the area. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
