ORDINANCE: 56-14

PASSED: October 15, 2014

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING CARLTON A. DAVIS AS A POLICE OFFICER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Carlton A. Davis was appointed to the position of Police Officer on October 2, 2013, and,

WHEREAS, Obetz Charter Section 3.09(c) requires a one year probationary period; and,

WHEREAS, Mayor D. Greg Scott recommends final appointment of Carlton A. Davis to the position of Police Officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Carlton A. Davis is hereby confirmed as a Police Officer effective October 2, 2014.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the immediate passage of which is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Obetz, such emergency arising from the need to ensure a quality police force; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
