REGULAR MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 8, 2014

The Obetz Village Council met in regular session on September 8, 2014 at 6:00 PM at the Obetz Government Center located at 4175 Alum Creek Drive with Mayor D. Greg Scott presiding.
