ORDINANCE: 54-14

PASSED: November 10, 2014

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING ERIC J. BAKER AS A POLICE OFFICER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Eric J. Baker was appointed to the position of Police Officer on November 12, 2013, and,

WHEREAS, Obetz Charter Section 3.09(c) requires a one year probationary period; and,

WHEREAS, Mayor D. Greg Scott recommends final appointment of Eric J. Baker to the position of Police Officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Eric J. Baker is hereby confirmed as a Police Officer effective November 12, 2014.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the immediate passage of which is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Obetz, such emergency arising from the need to ensure a quality police force; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
