ORDINANCE: 23-15

PASSED: March 9, 2015

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT THE DEDICATION OF 14.2 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, FOR PUBLIC USE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Covington Capital Corporation of Ohio, desires to donate approximately 14.2 acres to the Village of Obetz; and,

WHEREAS, the parcel, Franklin County Auditor's parcel number 186-000005, is depicted in Exhibit "A"; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Obetz owns land adjacent to the land offered for donation by Covington Capital Corporation of Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, this additional land will enable the Village to further enhance its park system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute all necessary conveyance documentation to accept the donation of parcel 186-000005 from Covington Capital Corporation of Ohio.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising from the need to accept this donation as soon as possible in order to allow the Village to incorporate this parcel into the planning previously underway for the adjacent property; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

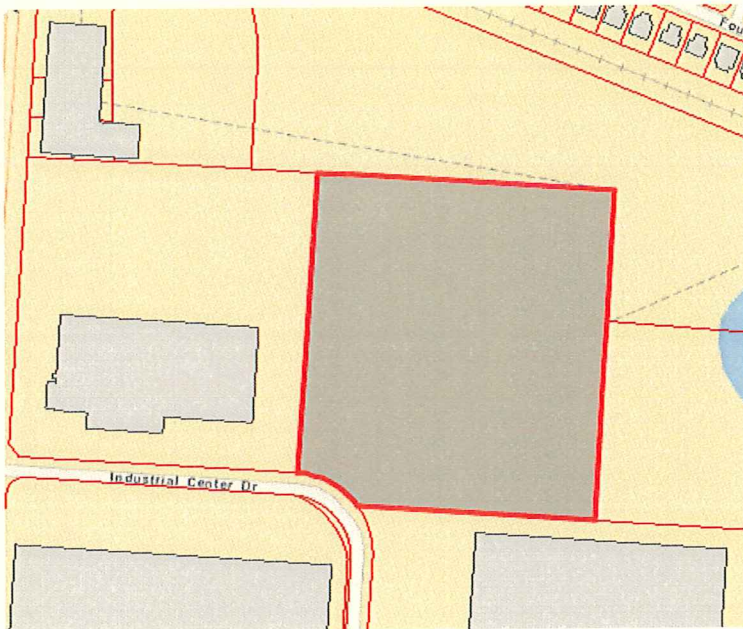
