AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO AWARD THE CONTRACT FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT RENOVATIONS TO R.W. SETTERLIN AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY
WHEREAS, the Village has requested and received bids for the renovation of the Police Department (the "Project"); and,
WHEREAS, R. W. Setterlin was the lowest and best bidder for said project; and,
WHEREAS, Council desires to award the bid for the Project to R. W. Setterlin;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:
Section 1. The Village Council awards the bid for the Project to R. W. Setterlin as the lowest and best bidder for the project.
Section 2. The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into a contract with R. W. Setterlin in the approximate amount of \$175,000.
Section 3. This Ordinance shall be declared an emergency and shall take effect from and after its passage. The reason for the emergency is to provide for the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Obetz, specifically, the Village needs to complete the renovations in a timely manner in order to improve operations of the Police Department.
