ORDINANCE: 58-15

PASSED: September 14, 2015

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH SEPTEMBER 8, 2015 AS A HOLIDAY FOR OBETZ EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Council to recognize the outstanding service and dedication of Obetz employees during 2015 ZucchiniFest and the opening Dixon Quarry; and,

WHEREAS, declaring Tuesday, September 8, 2015 as a holiday would give employees a four day period to spend with family and friends;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. September 8th is hereby declared to be a holiday for Obetz full-time employees for the year 2015 only. This date shall be treated as a holiday pursuant to Section 149.05 of the Village's Codified Ordinances.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the immediate passage of which is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Obetz, such emergency arising from the immediate need to finalize schedules and adjust records for bookkeeping purposes; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
