WHEREAS, the amount of delinquent user charges for the Refuse Fund has increased over the last year causing a cash flow problem in the Refuse Fund; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COU	JNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:
Section 1. For the purpose of providing fund be and is hereby advanced from the General Fur as a transfer.	Is for the Refuse Fund, the amount of \$70,000 nd. The amount is solely an advance, and is not
Section 2. The advance shall be repaid from the collections of the Refuse Fund as funds become available after meeting all obligations of the fund.	
Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising from the need to ensure adequate funds exist to pay for the removal of trash from the Village; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
