AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE RECODIFICATION, EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF OBETZ AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Obetz, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, numerous sections in the Traffic, General Offenses and Fire Prevention Codes need to be updated to reflect legislation enacted by the Ohio General Assembly;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the recodification, editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the ordinances and parts of ordinances of the Village of Obetz are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of Obetz, Ohio, as set forth in the 2017 Replacement Pages so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances.
