Ms. Boumis read Ordinance 06-18: An Ordinance Approving The Village Of Obetz Annual Conversion Plan Which Allows Employees To Convert Vacation And Sick Time To Cash In Accordance With The Ohio Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS) Specifications. Mr. Davisson stated that the Village has been doing this for several years. The program is voluntary and creates a lower absentee rate. Mike Confer, Police Chief — Chief Confer stated that since the last meeting, officers have responded to 240 dispatched runs and had 1098 pick-up runs.
