

ORDINANCE: 37 – 18



PASSED:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ELIGABILITY REQUIREMNTS FOR HEALTH CARE BENEFITS
WHEREAS, under Section 3.10 of the Village Charter, Council has the authority to establish o authorize the establishment of benefits and conditions of employment as it deems proper; and
WHEREAS, currently an eligible employee for benefits purposes is a person who regularly work full time 40 or more hours per week; and,
WHEREAS, eligible employee also includes the Village's Mayor,
WHEREAS, the Village would like to expand the eligibility requirements to include all elected officials of the Village; and,
WHEREAS, no current member of Council would be eligible for benefits during their current term of office; and,
WHEREAS, this benefit would be phased in following future municipal elections and only newly elected officials that are beginning their term would be eligible.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT
Section 1. An eligible employee for purposes of receiving health care benefits shall include any person who is classified by the employer on both payroll and personnel records as a Employee who regularly works full time 40 or more hours per week and any elected official of the Village.
Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
