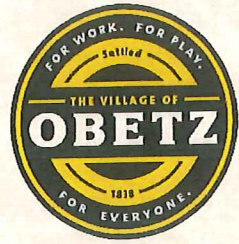

ORDINANCE: 33 – 18

PASSED: July 9, 2018

**AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE CHANGES TO THE 2018 APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance Number 61—17 approved the 2018 appropriations for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Obetz; and,

**WHEREAS**, changes to the 2018 appropriations are required for the payment of certain obligations and a reduction of appropriations is needed to meet statutory requirements or to better account for appropriation needs;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:**
