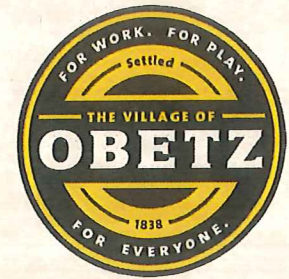

ORDINANCE: 56 - 18

PASSED: October 22, 2018

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A MODIFICATION TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ AND THE BIG WALNUT AREA COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT CORPORATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ordinance 30- 16 authorized the Village of Obetz ("Village") to enter into an agreement with the Big Walnut Area Community Improvement Corporation ("BWACIC") to administer the Village's Beautification Grant Program; and,

WHEREAS, the agreement caps the amount of financial assistance available to each property; and,

WHEREAS, the BWACIC and Village desire to increase this cap and make the amount of financial assistance available discretionary subject to appropriations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Village Council hereby approves a modification to the agreement between the Village and the BWACIC.

Section 2. The modification to the agreement shall be prepared by the Law Director.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising from the need to modify the agreement in this calendar year; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.


