WHEREAS, Police Week is an opportunity for the Obetz community to express their appreciation to these 20 officers who work tirelessly to ensure the safety of individuals living and working in Obetz; and,

WHEREAS, Police Week is also an opportunity to remember the many law enforcement officers that have given their lives in service of their communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mayor D. Greg Scott, recognize the hard work and dedication of the Obetz Police Force and proclaim the week of May 12 through 18, 2019 as Police Week in the Village of Obetz. Furthermore, I call upon all citizens of Obetz to observe May 15th as Peace Officers’ Memorial Day in honor of all those law enforcement officers throughout the country who, through their courageous deeds, have made the ultimate sacrifice in service to their community.
