REGULAR MEETING OF APRIL 8, 2019

The Obetz Village Council met in regular session on April 8, 2019 at 6:00 PM at the Obetz Government Center located at 4175 Alum Creek Drive with Mayor D. Greg Scott presiding.

Ms. Boumis read Ordinance 11 - 19: An Ordinance To Add Chapter 377 Entitled "Golf Carts" To The Codified Ordinances Of The Village Of Obetz.

Ms. Boumis read Ordinance 12 – 19: An Ordinance To Approve And Authorize The Village Administrator To Purchase Real Property From John W Warner And Richard L Warner Trust And Declaring An Emergency.

Ms. Boumis read Ordinance 07 - 19: An Ordinance Approving The Recodification, Editing And Inclusion Of Certain Ordinances As Parts Of The Various Component Codes Of The Codified Ordinances Of Obetz And Declaring An Emergency. Mr. Davisson stated that this is done each year to the permanent laws of the Village.

Michael Confer, Police Chief — Chief Confer stated that there have been 611 calls for service since the last meeting. He reported on the activities of the detective. The detective has 29 open cases and has closed 17 cases this year. He stated that the school resource officer is extremely busy. He further stated that Sergeant DeBolt is getting the bicycles ready to deploy.

Stacey Boumis, Community Services Director - Planning and Zoning Commission meets Wednesday.

Stephen J. Smith, Esq., Frost Brown Todd - No formal report.

E. Rod Davisson, Esq., Administrator - Mr. Davisson stated that the Ohio Machine has folded operations. The Fortress is fine and some cool events are coming to replace the weekends formerly reserved for the Ohio Machine. Seniors from Hamilton High School are coming to the Village tomorrow to learn about local government and tour the Village facilities. Mr. Davisson, Mr. Corbitt (Village Engineer), Council, and Mayor Scott discussed road improvements. Mr. Corbitt stated that it is \$2 million dollars per lane mile to redo a road. The Groveport Road/Williams Road intersection is controlled by the City of Columbus and it is now on the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission radar as an area that needs further study and modifications.
