ORDINANCE: 55 – 19

PASSED: December 16, 2019

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS TO PAY FOR HEALTH CARE BENEFITS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, for decades, the Mayor position has received health care benefits; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance 37–18, adopted August 27, 2018, expanded the eligibility requirements for health care benefits to include all elected officials; and,

WHEREAS, the cost for such benefits has not been established.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. All elected officials are eligible for all of the same health care benefits as full-time employees of the Village; and, shall pay the same costs for health care benefits as those full-time Village employees—as may be adjusted from time to time in the Village’s Health Care Plan.

Section 2. All elected officials are eligible to participate in the Village’s health savings account in the same way and by the same guidelines established for Obetz’ full-time employees unless otherwise prohibited by law.

Section 3. Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that the Village needs to adopt the rate for health care benefits prior to the beginning of the year; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
