ORDINANCE: 18 – 20

PASSED: May 26, 2020

**AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Council adopted Ordinance 14 – 20 on April 13, 2020 which declared a State of Emergency; and,

**WHEREAS**, the State of Emergency was set to expire on June 1, 2020; and,

**WHEREAS**, the number of COVID-19 cases has continued to rise in the State of Ohio; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to extend the State of Emergency in order to protect the citizens of Obetz.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

Section 1. The State of Emergency is extended until August 1, 2020.

Section 2. Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that the Village needs to protect the citizens of Obetz; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
