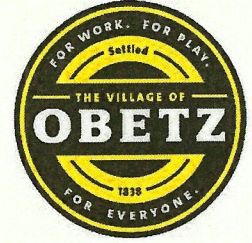

ORDINANCE: 38 – 20

PASSED: September 14, 2020

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE CHANGES TO THE 2020 APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ

WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 57-19 approved the 2020 appropriations for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village; and,

WHEREAS, additional Coronavirus Relief Funding was allocated to the Village of Obetz; and,

WHEREAS, changes to the 2020 appropriations are required for the payment of certain obligations and a reduction of appropriations is needed to meet statutory requirements or to better account for appropriation needs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:
