# **MAYOR'S REPORT**

Mayor Kirk showed a concept drawing for the new dog park that will be installed at Bridlewood Park. She then stated planning has begun on the Bixby Road/Groveport Road improvement project and the Mulberry Grove connector. Mayor Kirk also stated she drove around the Village with Code Enforcement. Code Enforcement has created a list of properties with multiple code violations. The letters on the Service Department building have been hung naming it the Kevin Hall Service Complex.

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mr. Kimbler, Parks and Programming – Mr. Kimbler stated Opening Day is Saturday from 6:00 to 9:00 PM. Rentals opened last week.

Mr. Varney, Fortress Obetz, Regional Recreation and Events – Mr. Varney stated tomorrow is a welcome home event for soldiers returning from Afghanistan. Last week there were approximately 400 people at Bike Night. At the May 9<sup>th</sup> SCCA there were 71 vehicles.

Mr. Richardson, Public Works and Safety – Mr. Richardson stated there was a big accident today at the intersection of Alum Creek Drive and Rathmell Road. Mayor Kirk and Council discussed regional traffic issues.

Mr. Flaherty, Development – Mr. Flaherty stated the Molto deal has been finalized and the Casto deal is pending.

Mr. Kramer, Intergovernmental Outreach – Mr. Kramer stated the Groveport Madison School District returns full time this week. Mayor Kirk stated the Village of Lockbourne has invited Obetz to participate in their Memorial Day parade. The Village will be constructing a float. Any Council members that want to participate should let her know.

Mrs. Wiley, Neighborhood Preservation and Beautification – Mrs. Wiley stated the Grounds crew has been working hard.
