ORDINANCE: 29 – 21	PASSED: August 9, 2021

AN ORDINANCE CREATING FOUR CORPORAL POSITIONS AND AN ADDITIONAL SERGEANT POSITION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Charter for the Village of Obetz was adopted by the electors at an election on November 3, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, the Charter sets forth requirements for Council to formally establish certain positions; and,

WHEREAS, there is a need for the Village of Obetz to create four new Corporal positions and an additional Sergeant position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OBETZ, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. Pursuant to Section 3.03(4) of the Charter for the Village of Obetz, Council hereby creates and establishes four Corporal positions and an additional Sergeant position within the Police Department. The rate of pay for Corporal shall be \$38.30/hour. The rate of pay for Sergeant is already established and is \$39.71/hour.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Mayor and Administrator shall take further action to make the appointment for the positions established herein.

<u>Section 3</u>. Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that the Village desires to establish the necessary position pursuant to the Charter and fill the position created; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
