AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE ANNEXATION OF 2.2 +/- ACRES FROM HAMILTON TOWNSHIP TO THE CITY OF OBETZ
WHEREAS, a petition for annexation of certain territory in Hamilton Township was duly filed by David Hodge representing The Lockbourne Road Properties Limited Trust; and,
WHEREAS, the petition was duly considered by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio on October 12, 2021, and said Board approved the annexation of such territory to
the City of Obetz; and,
WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners certified a copy of the Resolution approving said annexation with the map and petition to the Clerk of the City of Obetz who received the same on October 18, 2021; and,
WHEREAS, sixty (60) days from the date of receipt of the County Resolution granting the petition for annexation, has now lapsed in accordance with Section 709.04 of the Ohio Revised Code; and,
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:
Section 1: The petition for the annexation of 2.2 +/- acres, more or less, as shown on the annexation plat attached hereto as Exhibit A, to the City of Obetz is hereby accepted.
Section 2: The zoning for the parcels shall be Exceptional Use.
Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
