AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE BODY WORN CAMERA GRANT FUND (2061), TO ADVANCE FUNDS THERETO, TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City was accepted into the OCJS Body Worn Camera Grant program; and,

WHEREAS, State statute requires that the proceeds of debt be segregated in a separate fund to be spent for the purpose of the issuance; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. There is hereby established the Body Worn Camera Grant Fund **(2061)**, as a grant fund of the City, to account for the receipt and disbursement of the proceeds of the grant for the purpose of financing the Project.

Section 2. In order to provide initial funding for the Body Worn Camera Grant Fund for the purpose of furthering the goals, objectives and activities of said Fund, the following sum of up to \$75,959.36, be and is hereby advanced to the Body Worn Camera Grant Fund from the General Fund as needed to pay for the expenses that are payable prior to reimbursement by the Grant Program. This advance may be made in whole, or incrementally as deemed appropriate by the Finance Director.

The amount of \$75,959.36 is solely an advance, and not as a transfer or by any other means, for the sole and exclusive purpose of temporarily meeting the need for money to pay for the costs incident to the Project, as authorized by City Council, and with the anticipation of full and complete repayment and reimbursement to the General Fund. The reimbursement to the General Fund from the Body Worn Camera Grant Fund shall be from the proceeds of anticipated reimbursements, and that the Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to immediately reimburse the General Fund upon receipt of such proceeds.

Section 3. The sum of \$75,959.36 is hereby appropriated to Fund 2061, appropriation account 2061-800-500 Capital Outlay in anticipation of the grant funds.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the immediate passage of which is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Obetz, such emergency arising from the need to ensure that the City has appropriate funds to properly account for City receipts; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
