**AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE CHANGES TO THE 2022 APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF OBETZ**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance Number 43 – 21 approved the 2022 appropriations for the current expenses and other expenditures of the City; and,

**WHEREAS**, changes to the 2022 appropriations are required for the payment of certain obligations and a reduction of appropriations is needed to meet statutory requirements or to better account for appropriation needs.
