AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DISTRIBUTE A ONE-TIME BONUS TO ALL CURRENT PART-TIME CITY EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, in each of the past eighteen years Council has recognized the efforts of City employees to keep Obetz a great place to live, work, and play by authorizing end of year bonuses; and,

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize the continued dedicated service of the part time City employees for the year 2022;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> It is in the City's best interest to recognize the continued efforts of its employees during the 2022 calendar year and to enhance retention for future years.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City Administrator shall determine the payment to all part-time employees hired before November 1, 2022 based on a pro-rata share of \$0.36 per hour of work in 2022 up to \$375. No bonus will be given for less than \$25. The bonus will be paid before December 25, 2022, in recognition of their efforts this year.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising from the need to allow adequate time to process the bonus payments prior to December 25, 2022; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
