



ORDINANCE: 53 – 22

**AN ORDINANCE OPTING-IN TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S MUNICIPAL BRIDGE INSPECTION PROGRAM SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) has a Municipal Bridge Inspection Program; and,

**WHEREAS**, ODOT assumes and bear's 100% of the cost for the Bridge Inspection Program Services requested by Obetz and agreed to by the State; and,

**WHEREAS**, ODOT requires legislative consent to participate in the program;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBETZ, OHIO THAT:**

Section 1. The Deputy City Administrator/City Engineer is empowered to provide written authorization via email to the Director of Transportation of Obetz' participation in the Municipal Bridge Inspection Program.

Section 2. Obetz agrees that all right of way required for the project will be made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety such emergency arising from the need to promote highway safety; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
