## 1305.14 WRECKING PERMIT; BOND.

- (a) No permit to remove, burn or raze a building or structure shall be granted until notice of the application therefore has been given to the owners of lots adjoining the lot upon which the building or structure is to be moved, and to the owners of wires or other impediments the removal of which will be necessary; and an opportunity has been given the owners to be heard, before the City Administrator or his designee, or until a bond of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) as fixed by the City Administrator or his designee has been filed with him to indemnify the City for damages. The contractor requesting the permit shall show proof of workers compensation and liability insurance with the minimum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).
- (b) A certificate of non-hazardous materials shall be provided to the City before a permit to remove, burn or raze a building or structure shall be granted. A deposit shall be made to the City of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for all residential demolition and five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for all commercial/industrial buildings, which will be refunded upon proof of adequate disposal of all refuse in an approved landfill from the demolition of any building or structure.
