MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Kirk stated Full Throttle Thursdays have been a huge success. There has been good promotions/advertising this year. Staff is working on Zucchinifest. Mayor Kirk further stated she is working on several ordinances for consideration including one to prohibit semi-trucks from parking in residential neighborhoods.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

No committee meetings were held. No reports. Mr. Varney provided an update of activities at Fortress Obetz. Mr. Kramer stated Groveport Madison School District is opening a school based health center for students and their families.

ADMINISTRATION'S REPORT

Chief Michael Confer, Police Department – Chief Confer stated there were 1271 calls for service since the last meeting. Officers patrolled 5693 miles.

Rod Davisson, Esq., Administrator – Mr. Davisson stated things are very busy. He discussed Ohio House Bill 64 related to changes in eminent domain law. He explained the changes to the law. Eminent domain is a last resort. The legislature is going overboard. He then stated he can't remember the last time Obetz used eminent domain, but the time may come when the City needs this power.

REMARKS FROM THE AUDIENCE

Andy Borders stated the community yard sale should be moved to the Fortress. Mayor Kirk stated she wanted to have a flea market at the Fortress. Mr. Borders then stated the Rathmell Road right of way needs cut.
