ORDINANCE: 17 – 24

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR SUBMIT A NATUREWORKS GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the State of Ohio NatureWorks grant program; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Obetz desires financial assistance under the NatureWorks Grant Program for installation of a kayak launch dock at Dixon Quarry;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. City Council hereby approves filing an application for financial assistance.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

<u>Section 3</u>. The City of Obetz does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the NatureWorks Grant Program.

<u>Section 4</u>. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising from the need to submit the grant application prior to the deadline; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
