Instructions to Recover Your Impounded Vehicle

In the event that your vehicle has been impounded or towed by the police department, the following is a general guideline of the necessary paperwork you will need in order to claim your vehicle.

1. Come to the police department office between the hours of 8:30am to 5:00pm Monday through Friday
Obetz Police Department's office is closed on Saturday, Sunday and Holidays

If after hours, you can contact the Franklin County Sheriff's Office at 614-525-3333 and an officer can meet with you at the police department to obtain your release form. Please make sure you have the proper paperwork before calling.

Please bring the following paperwork with you:

2. Proof of vehicle ownership (one of the following must be presented):
 - a. Current valid registration (If your registration is in your vehicle, you must call the towing company to retrieve it)
 - b. Title in your name
 - c. Signed-over title with a notarized Bill of Sale for each transfer (within 30 days of transfer date)
 - d. Rental vehicles require a valid rental contract in your name

Insurance documents are NOT accepted as proof of vehicle ownership

3. Bring the following Photo Identification
 - a. Valid Driver's License
 - b. State ID
 - c. Military ID
4. Payments are made to the towing company where your vehicle is located. You may call them and ask what the total fee and their forms of payment options are.
