ORDINANCE: <u>54 – 25</u>

PASSED: September 22, 2025

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO MAKE PAYMENT ON CONTRACTS WITH 120 WATER, INC., ZENNER USA, AND ACME ELECTRIC, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, 120 Water, Inc. provides yearly contractual services for Ohio Environmental Protection Agency lead and copper tracking; and,

**WHEREAS**, Zenner USA provides annual hosting services and system maintenance for the Utilities Department; and,

WHEREAS, Acme Electric provides electrical services and equipment to Zucchinifest; and,

WHEREAS, Section 5705.41(D)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code provides that in certain circumstances a subdivision may authorize payment on a contract executed without prior certification by the subdivision's Director of Finance; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council now has before it three certificates from the Director of Finance certifying there was at the time of the making of that contract and at the time of the execution of such certificate a sufficient sum appropriated for the purpose of such contract and in the treasury or in process of collection to the credit of an appropriate fund free from any encumbrances (a "then and now certificate"); and,

**WHEREAS**, less than thirty days have passed since the City Council's receipt of the certificate from the Director of Finance; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to satisfy the obligations of the contracts;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBETZ, OHIO, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. City Council hereby acknowledges receipt of a "then and now certificate" from the Director of Finance and authorizes and directs the Director of Finance to make payment not to exceed the amount \$3,435.36 to 120 Water, Inc.

<u>Section 2</u>. City Council hereby acknowledges receipt of a "then and now certificate" from the Director of Finance and authorizes and directs the Director of Finance to make payment not to exceed the amount \$6,864.20 to Zenner USA.

PASSED: September 22, 2025

City Council hereby acknowledges receipt of a "then and now certificate" from the Section 3. Director of Finance and authorizes and directs the Director of Finance to make payment not to exceed the amount \$27,000 to Acme Electric.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising from the need to comply with statutory timelines concerning "then and now certificates"; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
