ORDINANCE: 06 – 26

PASSED: February 2, 2026

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR A CONTRACTING PROCEDURE FOR THE JERMOORE ROAD RIPARIAN STREAM RESTORATION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Obetz was awarded a grant for the restoration of the stream along Jermoore Road; and,

WHEREAS, the project is a technically complex ecological restoration effort involving stream channel stabilization, riparian corridor restoration, water quality enhancement, and compliance with multiple local, regional and state environmental standards; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Obetz desires to waive competitive bidding and establish a specific contracting procedure for purposes of negotiating a proposal and entering into a contract for the Jermoore Road Riparian Stream Restoration Project; and,

WHEREAS, the Council is empowered to enact ordinances for the waiver of competitive bidding in the awarding of contracts by Section 8.02(C) of the City Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBETZ, OHIO, NO LESS THAN FIVE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby finds and declares that, as a “home rule” charter city, Obetz shall not be obligated to follow statutory procedures regarding contracting, including but not limited to Ohio Revised Code Sections 721.01-721.03, 731.141, 9.312, 9.313, 9.32, 9.33-9.332, 153.12-153.14, 153.50-153.52, 153.34, 153.56-153.571, 153.67-153.71, 735.05-735.09, and other applicable sections within O.R.C. Chapter 153.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 8.02(C) of the City Charter, City Council hereby waives competitive bidding with regard to the contract for the Jermoore Road Riparian Stream Restoration Project.

Section 3. Council hereby empowers the City Administrator to select a contractor which is in the best interest of the City of Obetz and execute a contract.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety such emergency arising from the need to ensure compliance with the timelines of the grant; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
